- describe leading theories linking risk and return on a stock market;
- provide an overview of the current technological development in the financial sector.

Financial statements and financial ratio analysis;

- Cash and operating cycles, growth rates;

- Financial forecasting;

- Time value of money and investment decision rules;
- Introduction to risk and return;
- Portfolio theory and capital asset pricing model;
- Emerging technology trends in financial services.
