Application phase

Utilizing the Ulysseus Experts Database.

Recruiting potential group members and collecting group information.

Reaching a consensus among members.

Developing and submitting application form.

Applications evaluation

Evaluation is conducted at both the local university and central levels.

The assessment includes the quality and potential contributions of the group.

Alignment with the strategic objectives of Ulysseus, particularly the IH themes, is assessed.

The societal and economic implications are considered.

Implementation of activities

Implementation of planned activities.

Ensuring the sustainability of the group.

Reporting

Grant report after 12 months.





Ulysseus

- Mapping existing research and pedagogical expertise at Ulysseus partner universities.
- Support the networking of experts (researchers and teachers) among partners.
- Identify active experts interested in the internationalization of their research/teaching activities.
- First step in the process of creating joint Ulysseus research groups.
- Data will be available only for internal needs within the framework of (access to data will be managed).


- Strategize and implement targeted efforts to improve participation in EU-funded projects, leveraging Ulysseus' strengths
- Optimize the submission process by offering workshops and one-to-one consultations, to increase the success rate of EU projects






